More Information

- Prior authorization is required for diabetic monitoring supplies from non-preferred manufacturers. If supplies from non-preferred manufacturers are approved by Health Partners Medicare, you will pay 20% coinsurance.
- Diabetic test strips have quantity limits. You can receive 150 test strips per 30 days (or up to 450 test strips per 90 days). Prior authorization is required if you need a higher quantity per month.
